You can explore both Hindu and Buddhist cultural landmarks, making this tour a perfect combination of history, spirituality, and local lifestyle. Kathmandu Durbar Square & Boudhanath Stupa

Visit Kathmandu Durbar Square, located in the heart of Kathmandu, where you will explore ancient temples, the royal palace, museums, and the Kumari (Living Goddess) house. Later, visit Boudhanath Stupa, one of the largest Buddhist stupas in the world, surrounded by monasteries and Tibetan culture.

ALT: 1,400m HIKE: 4–5 hrs

Patan Durbar Square & Swayambhunath (Monkey Temple)

Visit Patan Durbar Square, known for its temples, Golden Temple, and ancient architecture. Then visit Swayambhunath, a hilltop stupa offering panoramic views of the valley and filled with prayer flags and monkeys.

ALT: 1,400m HIKE: 4–5 hrs

Pashupatinath Temple & Bhaktapur Durbar Square

Visit Pashupatinath Temple, a sacred Hindu site with cremation ghats along the Bagmati River. Then explore Bhaktapur Durbar Square, known for its 55-window palace, Nyatapola Temple, and traditional architecture.

ALT: 1,400m HIKE: 5–6 hrs

Namo Buddha Visit

Visit Namobuddha, a sacred Buddhist pilgrimage site located on a hilltop. Explore monasteries, caves, and enjoy beautiful mountain and nature views.

ALT: 1,750m HIKE: 4–5 hrs

05

Budhanilkantha & Nagi Gumba

Visit Budhanilkantha Temple, known for its large reclining Vishnu statue in water. Then hike to Nagi Gumba, a peaceful nunnery located in the forest.

ALT: 1,600m HIKE: 4–5 hrs

06

Chovar & Pharping Exploration

Visit Chovar (Manjushree Hills), known for caves and legends. Then explore Pharping, famous for monasteries and Asura Cave, an important Buddhist meditation site.

ALT: 1,400m HIKE: 4–5 hrs

07

Sankhu, Vajrayogini Temple & Milarepa Cave

Visit Sankhu village, Vajrayogini Temple on the hilltop, and nearby Milarepa Cave in the forest. Experience local culture and scenic surroundings.

ALT: 1,500m HIKE: 4–5 hrs

08

Kapan Monastery, Phulari Monastery & Gokarneshwor Temple

Visit Kapan Monastery and nunnery, then hike to Phulari Monastery with forest views. End the tour at Gokarneshwor Temple, one of the oldest temples in the valley.

ALT: 1,400m HIKE: 5-6 hrs
