THE OVERVIEW

Chitwan National Park was established in 1973 AD and is located at an altitude of around 200 meters above sea level. It is one of the most popular destinations in Nepal for travelers who want to explore wildlife and experience the unique Tharu culture. The park is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1979 and is one of the richest natural areas in the Terai region, the subtropical southern part of Nepal. It is home to a wide variety of wildlife, including 68 species of mammals, 544 species of birds, and many reptiles and aquatic animals. Chitwan is...

Kathmandu to Chitwan by Tourist Bus

Drive from Kathmandu to Chitwan by tourist bus (approximately 4–5 hours). Enjoy scenic views of rivers, hills, and countryside landscapes along the way. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel or resort and receive a briefing about jungle activities.

Full Day Jungle Activities in Chitwan

Enjoy a full day of jungle activities in Chitwan National Park. Activities include jungle safari (jeep or elephant), canoeing on the Budhi Rapti River, bird watching, visiting the elephant breeding center, and exploring the Tharu village. In the evening, enjoy a traditional Tharu cultural dance performance.
